

1. Maximum load weight is 300 pounds (136.1 kg).



GENERAL INFORMATION, TIPS and TRICKS

- 1. Please read the Assembly Instructions prior to assembling the unit.
- 2. To avoid damage, assemble the unit on a sturdy, level and non-abrasive surface.
- 3. Keep all hardware part out of reach of children.
- 4. Please wait until all steps are completed before tightening bolts.
- 5. Make sure all bolts are tightly fastened before the unit is used.


Parts and Hardware List

Please read completely through the instructions and verify that all parts listed are present before beginning assembly.



<u>Tools required</u>: Allen Key (provided) and Phillips Screwdriver (not provided).


Assembly Instructions



- 1. Unpack the unit and confirm that you have all the hardware and required parts listed.
- 2. Lay a CHAIR BACKREST (A) on a smooth and protective surface with the threaded inserts facing up.
- 3. Place SEAT FRAME (B) onto the middle rail of the CHAIR BACKREST (A). Make sure that the counter sunk screw holes on the SEAT FRAME face floor after assembly. Insert and screw the M6 x 75 mm BOLTS (3) with LOCK WASHERS (4) and FLAT WASHERS (5) through the pre-drilled holes on the seat frame at rear corner blocks and loosely tighten into the threaded inserts on the BACKREST.
- 4. Secure the SEAT FRAME (B) onto the CHAIR BACKREST (A) by inserting two M6 x 35 mm BOLTS (1) with WASHERS (4 & 5) through the pre-drilled holes on the rear rail of seat frame. Tighten the bolts with enclosed ALLEN KEY.


NOTE: DO NOT over-tighten the bolts.

Assembly Instructions



- 5. Attach two FRONT LEGS (D) to the front corner blocks of SEAT FRAME (B) by inserting M6 x 60 mm BOLTS (2) with WASHERS (4 and 5) through the pre-drilled holes on corner blocks into the threaded inserts on FRONT LEGS. Tighten the bolts with enclosed ALLEN KEY.
 - **NOTE:** DO NOT fully tighten all the bolts until the chair been adjust and level all the legs so that they do not wobble. Once adjusted then go back and tighten while making sure that the unit remains level.
- 6. Stand assembled chair upright on a flat surface. Press down SEAT FRAME (B) to even all legs. Now tightly fasten all bolts with enclosed Allen Key.

- 7. Flip assembled chair upside down and attach to the bottom of SEAT BOARD (C) making sure it is centered properly. Secure the SEAT BOARD in place by inserting five M4 x 38 mm Screws (6) into the countersunk holes on SEAT FRAME (B). Tighten the screws with a Phillips Screwdriver.
- 8. Stand the chair upright
- 9. Repeat the process to assemble the other Chair.

Care and Maintenance

- From time to time please ensure there are no loose nuts on the product.
- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- Use of furniture polish is not necessary. Should you choose to use polish, test first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage your furniture's finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Always use coasters under beverage glasses and flowerpots.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Using a soft clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.
- Always use protective pads under hot dishes and plates. Heat can cause chemical changes that may create spotting within the furniture finish.
- Stains or marks from crayons or ink markers will be difficult to remove.
- In the event that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.
- Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

Further advice about wood furniture care

It is best to keep your furniture in a climate-controlled environment. Extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause fading, warping, shrinking and splitting of wood. It is advised to keep furniture away from direct sunlight as sun may damage the finish.

Proper care and cleaning at home will extend the life of your purchase. Following these important and helpful tips will enhance your furniture as it ages.
